- In all classes where certificate of registration is required, the same or an application for, must be produced at the time of entry.
- Animals registered jointly by two juniors may only be exhibited by one. If an animal is jointly owned by a junior and a non-junior, it must be shown in the Open Division.
- Tattoos will be checked by the Show Committee and will have the authority to remove any animal from the show if the tattoo does not correspond with the one stated on the registration papers. Purebred calves born in the calendar year MUST be tattooed and registered.
- Each animal may only be entered in one conformation class.
- Calves may be shown with their dams or individually. In the event that both would qualify to advance, only one animal unit can advance.
- Age of animals is based on January 1st of the competition year.
- All 2 year old females and mature females entered in the conformation classes must be accompanied by their natural calendar year calf.
- Embryo Transfer calves cannot be shown with their donor mothers.
- Recipient cows cannot be shown with Embryo Transfer calves.

Divisions—Classes

An animal may only be entered in one division. A junior is only able to have one entry per class, but can be in every class in a division if they chose.

Commercial Division: animals must be at least 50% Limousin and show Limousin characteristics. Animals may be disqualified if they do not meet these requirements. This will be left to the discretion of the Show Committee. Animals in this division do not qualify for the Overall Champion Class, but will have their own Champion Class.

- Class 100-Heifer calf
 - Class 101-Yearling heifer
 - Class 102-Two year old cow/calf
 - Class 103-Mature cow/calf
- Champion & Reserve Commercial Female

Steer Division: steers must be half blood or higher percentage to compete and sired by a registered Limousin bull or out of a registered purebred Limousin cow.

- Class 200-Prospect steer/calendar year calf
- Champion Prospect Steer
- Class 201-Market steer
- Champion Market Steer

Open Division-Female: cattle entered in the Open Division may show anyone as the registered owner, but may only be the exhibit of one junior. This includes all leased cattle. Animals in this division do not qualify for the Overall Champion Class, but will have their own Champion Class.

- Class 300-Heifer calf
 - Class 301-Yearling heifer
 - Class 302-Two year old/calf
 - Class 303-Mature cow/calf
- Champion & Reserve Open Division Female

Open Division-Bull: same criteria apply as in the Open Division Female classes.

- Class 400-Bull calf
- Champion & Reserve Open Division Bull

Purebred Division: animals whose registered owner is the junior member or junior member's family.

- Class 500-Heifer calf
- Class 501-Yearling heifer
- Class 502-Two year old cow/calf
- Class 503-Mature cow/calf

Bred & Owned Division-Bull: animals whose registered owner & registered breeder is the junior member.

- Class 600-Bull calf
- Champion & Reserve Bred & Owned Bull

Bred & Owned Division-Female: same criteria apply as in bred & owned bull class.

- Class 700-Heifer calf
 - Class 701-Yearling heifer
 - Class 702-Two year old cow/calf
 - Class 703-Mature cow/calf
- Overall Champion & Reserve Female (from purebred and bred & owned division)

General Rules & Regulations:

- Any exhibitor making entry, by doing so agrees to the rules and regulations of the conference.
- The production of any animal may be ordered by the show committee in charge for viewing or other purposes at any time during the conference, and any participant refusing or neglecting to bring such animals out as directed shall forfeit his entry and any prizes that may be awarded him.
- There is to be no adult participation. Juniors are encouraged to assist other juniors with their tasks. This will be strictly enforced by the show committee. Violations could result in dismissal from competition.
- Any acts of fraud, deception, or dishonest practice, either in the preparation or ownership of the entry which may have been intended to affect or affected the decision of the judges will be dealt with at the discretion of the show committee.
- All cattle must adhere to Regional Health Regulations.
- All animals will be subject to veterinary inspection.
- No person shall be permitted in the show ring during the time of judging except the judge or assistants, persons in charge of animals, committee members and photographers.
- Any person who shall attempt to interfere with or influence the judges while in the discharge of their duties, or who shall on the premises of the conference use contemptuous or abusive language to the judge, in the consequences of the awards made by him, shall forfeit his right to all premiums which he might otherwise be entitled to, and shall be excluded from exhibiting next year. Judges are particularly requested to report any breach of this rule.
- Judges in making awards are to confine themselves to the classes in the prize list.
- Alcohol and drugs are prohibited in the barns.
- Any exhibitor lodging a protest must make it in writing to the show committee before 8:00a.m. the next day following the cause of the protest. It must plainly state the cause of the complaint or appeal, and must be accompanied by a deposit of \$5.00 which sum shall be forfeited if the said person is not sustained.
- The CLA as well as the CJLA Provincial and National Committees and/or any of its employees and the Host Fairgrounds and/or any of its employees are not responsible for any accidents/thefts during the time prior to, during or after the conference.
- Though the committee will take every precaution to ensure the safety of the cattle sent to the show, they wish it distinctly understood that the owners themselves must take the risk of exhibiting them and that if any animal is injured, lost or stolen, the committee will not make payment for the value thereof.
- Any animal whilst on the premises for the conference, or any other purpose, shall be on such premises entirely at the risk of the owner thereof, and the committee will not be liable for damage which may be claimed by reason of any accident or injury to such animals, in any way whatsoever.
- Exhibitors of animals liable to occasion accidents, injury or damage to persons coming in contact therewith, shall indemnify the committee from and against all claims and demands, costs, charges and expenses which may incur, suffer, or be put to, by any reason of accidents or of any person being injured or suffering damage through or by any reason of such exhibits not being properly guarded, or the public not being properly protected from same.
- The committee will not be responsible for any injury to person or property of anyone, notwithstanding that the injury may occur on the property during the show whether or not such injury shall have been caused by negligence of the committee, or any other person.

Competitions:

Team Grooming-teams of three participants will be made up by the show committee

- Chutes will be supplied, but participants must bring an animal.
- Animal must be washed and dried before the competition begins.
- Clippers, blowers and any necessary show supplies may be used.
- Once at chute area you are not allowed to leave so bring all equipment with you.

Show Team Judging

- The teams are expected to judge a class of cattle in a show ring setting.
- Teams of two participants preferably from the same category.
- If you don't have a partner, one will be assigned.
- Dress is Western Formal
- One of the team members will act as the judge and the other will act as the ring person.
- The participant acting as the judge must give oral reasons over the microphone in front of an audience.
- All other teams must be out of the judging area and unable to hear reasons being given by the other teams until they have completed their competition.

Photography- theme "A Prairie to be Proud Of"

- The photograph must be taken by the participant exhibiting it.
- Photographs must be no smaller than 4"x6" and no larger than 8"x10".
- Photographs must not be framed.
- Photographs must be handed in at registration.
- Only one photo per participant is allowed.
- Please put your show number on the back of your photo for identification.
- Your photo may be kept for promotional purposes.

Showmanship- additional rules to that of the CJLA rules.

- Showmanship classes will be held separately from conformation classes.
- Animals will be made available for participants not exhibiting animals.
- Cows may be shown but without calf at side.
- Participants must have appropriate show attire of choice.

Public Speaking-Participants will speak on a pre-assigned topic.

- Speeches must be written by the participant.
- All participants will be present in the competition area 15 minutes prior to the competitions scheduled start time.
