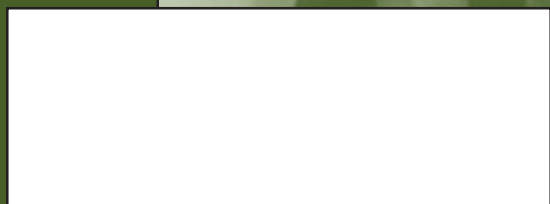
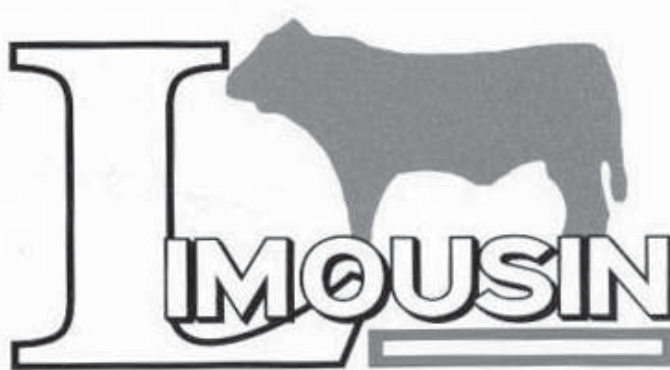

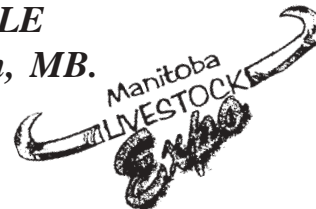

Market is hot for Limos!

As I travel to various Auctions across the country and view some of the early fall run sales, it is obvious the time is right for the breed. The need for high yielding Limousin influenced calves has never been stronger. There are many marketing opportunities defined for the Limousin breed from niche targeted markets to influenced fall feeder sales endorsed by prominent auction markets across the country. Source verification and age verification will pay off dividends for certain market opportunities.

Please make an effort to help your commercial customers and yourselves access these markets. Complete the feeder fax forms, encourage your customers to do the same, forward them to the CLA office so we can promote the offerings in a manner that they will be recognized; such as the Limousin website and faxed to auction markets and order buyers to view. Take a copy of the completed feeder fax with you to the market when you sell your calves, attach it to the manifest so when your calves or your customer's go through the ring, the Auctioneer will be armed with the facts regarding them and the management practices attached to them. If you are looking for a Limousin influenced sale this fall, (either live or satellite/internet), then please review the complete listing in the Bottom Line newsletter. If you have consignments or have encouraged your commercial customers to consign, please show your support and attend these sales. It is a great way to keep in touch with the markets, observe what the buyers are looking for and an even greater way to meet new potential customers as well as support your existing ones. Don't get left behind, the market is hot and the options are plentiful – take advantage of them.

I would encourage you all to exercise your right as a member and plan to attend the National event and Annual meeting in Regina, November 22-24th. Your beliefs and your vote are what will create the future direction of the association. With the new format for directors outlined in the Nomination Committee report, the opportunity to nominate from the floor and to vote on candidates is the responsibility of the members.

The vast expansion of circulation of the magazine is a result of members contributing contact names through completed transfers of ownership to buyers of your Limousin genetics. If you haven't already done so, please ensure that you have completed all the necessary paperwork for your buyers and please have the paperwork in place for the fall sales.

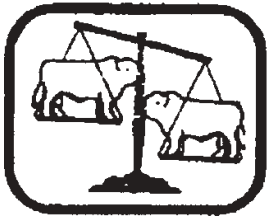

Manitoba Beef Cattle Performance Assoc. Inc.

The 2006-2007 bull test season is upon us. At the Annual Meeting in June of the Douglas Station, Todd Wallace was elected as president for the Test Station.

A new manager, Ivan Ahnholz, has been hired. Ivan has been herdsman for the Station for several years and is very much qualified to wear both hats as manager and our herdsman. A part-time secretary has been hired to help Ivan at busy times. This staffing change will cut costs and improve our bottom line.

Ivan is full of optimism and open to new ideas to improve the Station.

This season will include a new program which is a steer feeding project. Each steer consignor can put a minimum of 5 steers from a herd sire on the program, but this does not limit each consignor to one herd sire. If you have more than one sire group, this would be great. Gathering data such as gain and carcass data on the steers will give producers more information to help with their sire selections and herd improvement. The steer project is open to commercial cattlemen as well.

The replacement heifer program will be running again this year under the same guidelines as last year. Delivery dates for all cattle was October 10 to 14 but if you are reading this after the 14th please give Ivan a call, he may still have room for your consignments. 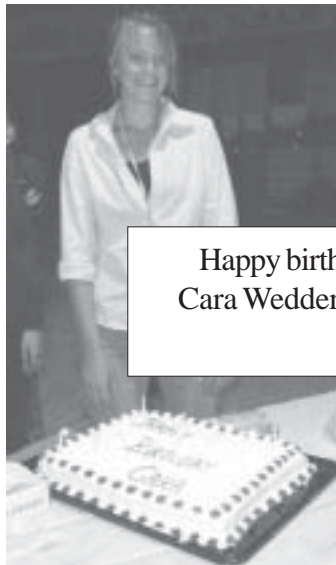
